Webinar: Harnessing of our knowledge of weed biology to better manage feathertop Rhodes grass and barnyard grass

Controlling summer grass weeds requires a strategy with interventions at various stages of the growing season. Bhagirath will explain the biology of the most problematic grass weeds and how to employ strategies that will provide your summer crop and subsequent winter crop with ideal conditions for growth. "In an environment, where there are initial low weed numbers the crop's ability to compete and suppress weed growth is improved," says Bhagirath.
